A Babich Black Label Sauvignon Blanc 2013 \$21.99 per bottle \$250.00 per dozen

Marlborough, New Zealand. The bouquet is an inviting mix of tropical, passionfruit aromas with notes of musk and box hedge. Palate entry is luscious and lively, bursting with red current, gooseberry and passionfruit, rounding off with a hint of capsicum. This is a fantastic example of Sauvignon Blanc that is equally enjoyable on its own and with food.

B Cool Woods Pinot Gris 2013 \$12.99 per bottle \$145.00 per dozen

Eden Valley, South Australia. The colour is light straw. The lifted nose has perfumed pear drops, orange blossoms and dried herbs. The palate is medium bodied with nice rich nectarine fruit, musk and freshly cut apples. This viscous and mouth filling wine is a perfect match to any food type, especially Asian foods. The rich sweet pear and nectarine flavours integrate with the clean acid to give the wine great length.

C Sevenhill Indigo Riesling 2013 \$18.50 per bottle \$215.00 per dozen

Clare Valley, South Australia. Brilliant in clarity, pale straw in colour with youthful green tints. Aromatic and overt, the nose is a riot of lemons and limes, florals and delicate perfumes. The palate combines generous lemon and lime flavours with a fresh core of natural acidity.

D Marquis de la Tour Sparkling Brut \$18.99 per bottle \$220.00 per dozen

Loire Valley, France. There's a lot of freshly baked bread aromas in this delightful bubbly, along with peach pie and even apricot. This is an intense wine, dry and scouring with a crisp tartness following through on the finish.

E Azahara Sparkling Chardonnay Pinot NV \$11.99 per bottle \$132.00 per dozen

This Australian Sparkling wine won a trophy awarded at the London International Wine Show recently. It was in the esteemed company of Champagne Houses such as Mumm, Taittinger and Piper Hiedsieck. Its Bright acidity is balanced by a creamy, malty body with fresh lemon, Camembert and breadly flavours and a good lengthy finish. A fine persistent mousse.

F Bellvale Estate Pinot Noir 2012 \$21.99 per bottle \$250.00 per dozen

Gippsland, Victoria. The nose displays up-front aromas of raspberries, wild strawberries and orange peel which gives way to a complex bouquet showing damp earth, cedar and notes of subtle, spicy oak. On the palate it has a soft, velvety mouthfeel with fresh, balanced acidity, fine-grained tannins and a long finish. The wine is showing great complexity and will drink well now and over the next 6 years.
